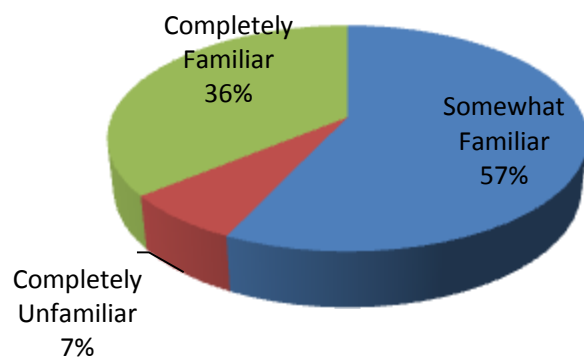
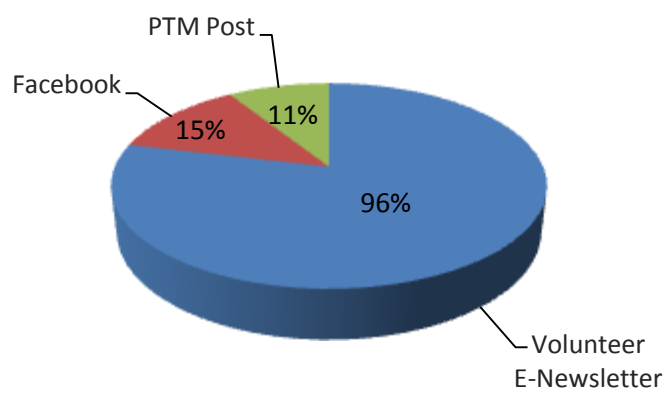

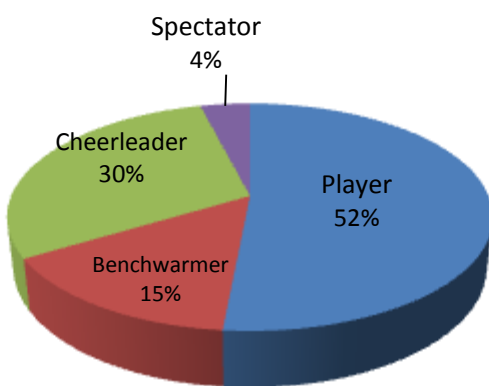

Player: In the middle of the action, feels ownership and influence in what's happening

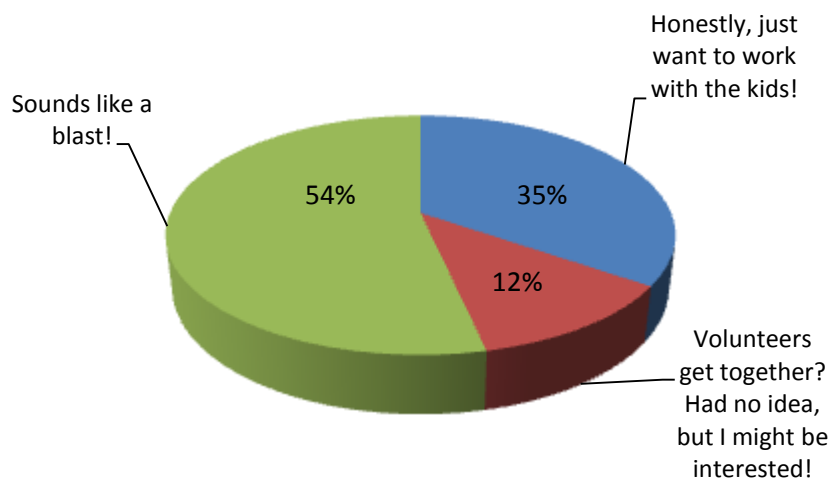
Benchwarmer: On the team, but I don't feel like I'm making a difference
